Our group counts every week, usually Monday morning, and processes all monies (currency and checks) received by UUAA during the previous week. These monies include the weekly offerings, pledges, memorial gifts, Comprehensive Campaign, Social Hour activities (Equal Exchange Coffee Project, QUUest Bookstore, Scrip, Alpha House, Khasi Hills, etc.), rental income, and other sources. Counting and processing involves filling out standard forms and double-counting to insure accuracy. Then we fill out bank deposit slips, and deposits are made by Ed Lynn or Debby Casamatta.

Each Church group that processes money fills out a standardized sheet that separates cash and checks and provides us and the individual groups with an accurate record of their financial activity. This allows for our work to proceed faster, with fewer questions.
