## 2016 Annual Report Arts and Aesthetics Committee

The Arts and Aesthetics committee is comprised of four regular member/congregants with consultation from other congregants, committees and staff. Our mission is to preserve and manage the collection of art and historical pieces owned by the congregation. We also make suggestions and implement approved plans for aesthetic improvements to certain public spaces at UUAA such as the foyer, hallway, Jackson Chapel, Social Hall, Narthex, Redman Room, and Sanctuary. This year, our efforts were focused on the following:
