Every Sunday morning in the Social Hall, the UUSC Coffee Project sells organic Equal Exchange products—coffee in a half dozen roasts, four kinds of tea, chocolate in ten different flavors, dried fruits, nuts, and olive oil. The Coffee Project is an ongoing fundraiser for UUSC's social justice program which works with small farming communities globally to bring about economic, social, and environmental justice. Equal Exchange (EE) is a democratic worker-owned co-operative that partners with the UUSC.

For every pound of product we purchase from EE, they donate 20 cents to UUSC. In the past year, UUSC profited over \$15,000 from UU churches nationally who are part of the Coffee Project. At UUAA we raised \$4,000 for our church from sales in the social hall.
