Every Sunday morning in the Social Hall, the UUSC Coffee Project sells organic Equal Exchange products—coffee in nine different roasts, six kinds of tea, chocolate bars in ten different flavors, dried fruits, nuts, and olive oil. The Coffee Project is an ongoing fundraiser for UUSC's social justice program that works with small farming communities globally to bring about economic, social, and environmental justice. Equal Exchange (EE) is a democratic worker-owned co-operative that partners with the UUSC.

Last year UUAA was one of EE's top buyers. For every pound of product we purchase from EE, they donate 20 cents to UUSC, and the Coffee Project also raises money for UUAA. Last year we raised \$4,000 for our church from sales in the social hall. During coffee hours the church serves flavorful EE coffee?
