- The Thrivent House: 1622 Wiard Rd., Ypsilanti
- We still need workers:
 - Saturday, August 29 (2 of 4 slots filled)
 - Saturday, September 19 (4 of 10 slots filled)
- Safety is a primary concern:
 - Safety guidelines are reviewed on-site before any work is done
 - A COVID 19 Volunteer Waiver is required
 - Social Distancing is enforced
 - Masks are required

The UUAA staff is happy to announce that UUAA is officially open for business again in a very limited way-- outdoors in designated areas of UUAA property Saturdays and Sundays only from 8 am -10 pm.

Recognized congregational groups and UUAA members may request to reserve outdoor space by first <u>reading</u> <u>the full outdoor space use policy</u> and then filling out the <u>Outdoor</u> <u>Space Request Form</u>. We want to keep everyone in our community safe, so please make sure that everyone in your group wears a mask and adheres to the policies carefully created by our Covid19 advisory team.

Enjoy the outdoor space, and please note that the building and the playground remain closed, so take into account that bathrooms are not available and there is no shelter for inclement weather. <u>Read</u> the full list of requirements in the policy document.
