### **Preparing for Goodbye**

• There are few things more meaningful to me as a minister than officiating at memorial services and weddings. Going forward, I will need to grieve losses and celebrate new beginnings from afar.

• I love the way that social media keeps me connected with friends all over the world. As your outgoing minister, I will maintain an appropriate distance virtually as well as geographically.

Does this mean that you shouldn't even say hello if we run into each other at General Assembly or some other event? Actually, I'd love for you to say hi. People from this congregation will always hold a place in my heart. By releasing each other from the way things have been, though, we all make room for our next chapters to unfold — me in New Haven, you here in Ann Arbor — held always by a love that will not let us go.
